- 4. Negotiations I. Sakinofsky
 - The TFA Mandate Meeting will be held on March 8, 2023, 12 2 p.m. in the Sears Atrium.
 - I. Sakinofsky presented highlights from the Mandate that will be used for bargaining. (Details from the Mandate will not be distributed electronically.)
 - Reps' were asked to encourage members to attend the Mandate Meeting.
 - · Discussion on various Mandate topics.
- 5. Announcements and Updates
 - Budget
 - Members are concerned with the calls for a 3.5% budget cut again this year.
 Faculty are encouraged to resist the budget cuts as much as possible. Student numbers continue to grow however, faculty numbers remain the same and the number of Teaching Assistants are decreasing. Departments/schools with growing programs should request more faculty positions.
 - The TFA is concerned with the Administration's plans to expand Navitas which would also bring more students to the University. The TFA is monitoring this closely.
 - Bill 124
 - Bill 124 was revoked in November 2022, though the Ford Government has appealed this decision. We have a provision in the arbitration award from the last contract that should the Bill be repealed the parties should attempt to renegotiate salaries for the period of the contract. TFA has requested a renegotiation of salaries for the past 3 years, ending July 2023. The Administration's offer was a one-time payout which was not acceptable. The TFA declined the offer but continues to negotiate and will give updates as they become available.
